 - Kids must know and communicate (not on website or emails)

Band Competitions: More info



- Students are bussed to and from every competition, leaving from and returning to JFK
- Upon return to JFK, all students assist in unloading the equipment trucks.
 Please pick up your student AFTER unloading is completed.
- NO student is ever left alone; a parent will always be the last to leave JFK.

UNIFORMS

- JFK provides the basic uniform includes:
 - Pants (Bibbers) and Jacket (with snap-on overlay)
 - Shakos, Gloves and Gauntlets
 - Shoes: All freshmen and 1st-year band members must purchase - \$32
- PARENTS (students) supply:
 - BLACK socks MANDATORY
 - Pep Band shirts or similar green shirt

FINANCES FOR THE JFK BAND


- School (district) pays for the band director's salary & benefits

PARENTS PROVIDE THE REST! We are a 501c3 Non-Profit entity, and depend on:


- Donations & Fundraising

FAIR SHARE: What is it? Why?

- The way we have to fund programs like band, with reduced support from school programs.
- Kennedy long history
- Allows us to remain competitive with other band programs in the
 - Purchase and maintenance of uniforms & accessories
 - Purchase and maintenance/repair instruments
 - Participate in competitions (entry fees)
 - Pay for additional instructors (marching, drums, color guard, etc.)



FAIR SHARE – for the Marching Band

For 2016-17: Fair Share = \$425 per band student

- Same as last year
- Multiple ways to reduce the personal/family impact:
 - Fireworks booth \$25 per shift
 - Pay Fair Share by 12/23/16 10% discount
 - Pre-sell event tickets:
 - Rehearsathon: 50% towards Fair Share
 - Mattress Fundraiser; \$ towards Fair Share for mattresses sold
 - Spaghetti Dinners: 50% towards Fair Share

NOTE: Jazz Band, Orchestra and Winter Drumline/Color Guard all have additional Fair Share Fees

How Parents Can Make Payments

- By CHECK: Make payable to:
 - John F. Kennedy Marching Band and Color Guard
- By CREDIT CARD:
 - We have a credit card machine and can take payment at events/activities – including the monthly Parents Booster meeting.
